





#### Definition of Deactivation

- No new students permitted to enroll in the program
- Programs registration is maintained
- Allows for the following:
  - Reassess the need for the program
  - Restructure the program
  - Currently enrolled students can graduate with the degree.
- This action is internal to SUNY and limited in duration to no more than three years, by which time the program must be reactivated or discontinued.



#### **SUNY PILOT**

- Provost with the Deans will Initiate Change of Status Form
- Deactivation Effective Date
  - January 1, 2026
  - The first regular admission date for which new students will no longer be permitted to enroll in the program


